From Servers to the Cloud

Today's non-profit finance leaders use modern technology to shift from reactive bookkeeping to proactive financial management—and Steve and his team of five finance professionals are no exception.

USET's legacy software, Abila (now MIP Fund Accounting), ran on in-house servers. *"It was actually on DOS when I started over 30 years ago," Steve notes.*

When support and updates for the server-based system ended, USET had two options to move to the cloud with Abila: strictly web-based or via an app.

"We would have lost quite a bit of functionality with the web-based version," Steve explains. "We opted to go with the app. That came with challenges we didn't anticipate."

Abila's app required a virtual private network (VPN) for remote access, and uploading and downloading files was tedious.



Steve says, "There were times when someone would say, 'I'm just uploading a PDF as a backup, and it's taking me five minutes'."

In addition to accounting software, USET's finance team used Microix, a third-party requisition solution. Attachments were stored in Microix, but it was difficult to get them into Abila.

An Invitation Leads to a Strategic Partnership

Steve began a search for new cloud-based accounting software with robust non-profit functionality. While he was evaluating options, he received email invitations for a Sage Intacct demo hosted by Vision33.

Sage Intacct's dimensional accounting is another benefit for USET. In traditional accounting, the chart of accounts is segmented to allow subaccounts, whereas dimensional accounting detaches the subaccounts from general ledger accounts.

Using dimensions provides many advantages, from keeping an organization's chart of accounts at its core minimum to allowing easy filtering, slicing, and dicing of financial reports.

The dimensions and reporting in Sage Intacct are very powerful," Steve says. "And you can choose how you set them up."





USET's disconnect between accounting software and a third-party requisition system is no longer an issue. Previously, the finance team had to transfer information from Microix to Abila to create a PO. *"With Sage Intacct, we have the ability to do these workflows in one system and not have a third-party feed into it,"* Steve says. *"I now have an actual requisition workflow, and it turns into a PO bill and gets converted. Sage Intacct offers an accrual system that makes sense."*

Steve appreciates Sage Intacct's user-friendliness and says he was surprised by how easy it is to upload budgets to the system. He's also happy with the seamless connection between Sage Intacct and Paylocity, USET's payroll provider.
